

The real McCain:

His record on workers' rights



John McCain is often portrayed in the media as a “maverick”. But based on his record in the Senate, the *real* McCain would give us **more of the same** anti-worker policies promoted by President Bush and his corporate contributors.

FACT: John McCain voted **AGAINST** raising the minimum wage.¹

FACT: John McCain voted to **TAKE AWAY** overtime from millions of American workers.²

FACT: John McCain voted **AGAINST** legislation to ban permanent replacements from taking our jobs during a labor dispute.³

FACT: John McCain voted **AGAINST** basic worker rights when he supported a national “Right-to-Work-for-Less” law to weaken our unions and our ability to bargain.⁴

FACT: John McCain voted **AGAINST** an ergonomics standard that would have protected tens of millions of workers from workplace injuries.⁵

FACT: John McCain voted **AGAINST** the Employee Free Choice Act, which would level the playing field and prevent employer abuses against workers who want to organize.⁶
