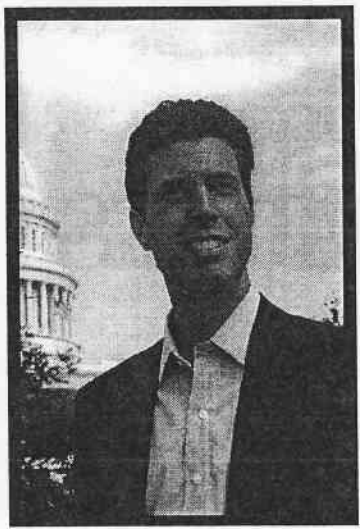

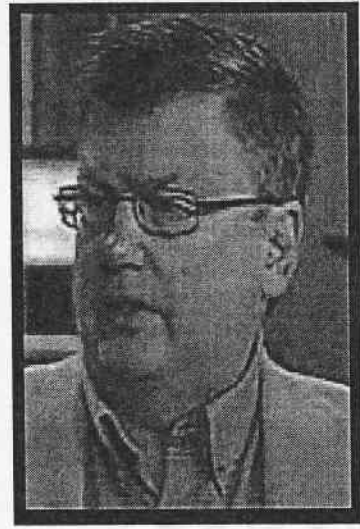
Who Will Fight For Working Families
